Education Support Program



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Karratha Primary School is an inclusive mainstream school with an endorsed Education Support program for students with additional needs. Eligible students will have a personalised plan delivered within the Education Support program and a range of inclusion opportunities appropriate for their development.

Eligibility

Our Education Support program is fluid and dynamic, specialising in education for students with substantial additional educational need requiring support and adjustments beyond the quality differentiated teaching and/or supplementary level. Eligibility for our Education Support program is based on the level of adjustments, support and intervention required for:

- Students with a diagnosed Intellectual Disability or Global Developmental Delay with an Individual Disability Allocation
- Students diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder who demonstrate a high educational need and eligibility for an Individual Disability Allocation.

Students with eligibility for an Individual Disability Allocation for Severe Mental Disorder, Severe Medical Health Condition or Physical Disability and a demonstrated high educational need that cannot be met at their local school, may be considered for local placement for the Education Support program at Karratha Primary School.

Our Facilities

Karratha Primary School's impressive facilities and beautifully landscaped grounds have been designed to support an inclusive environment for all our students. This includes five teaching areas with some classrooms designed for education support purposes, a specialised music room, specialised visual arts room, science laboratory, computer laboratory, library, hard courts, two undercover areas, low stimulus spaces, a sensory room, various play areas, a conference room to accommodate case management conferences with interagency support, and a dental clinic.

The school also has two bus collection points on the school grounds, one designed specifically to ensure the safety of our Education Support students. Students eligible for an Education Support enrolment are entitled to apply for the school bus service which currently services Karratha.

Our Program

Within the Education Support program, a higher staff to student ratio and less students in our classrooms. Experienced teachers and education assistants have specific expertise and training in educating students with disability, maximising opportunities to learn and foster student independence.

Each student has individualised plans written in consultation with parents and external providers including specialists and therapists, to ensure targeted academic, social and emotional goals and holistic, 'wraparound' care. Working with families and external providers, our students are supported to fulfil their educational and personal goals in order to successfully participate in all aspects of their lives and community. This is reported on formally at the end of each semester using SEN Reporting.

Enrolment

All enrolment applications are assessed according to Department of Education enrolment procedures.

Access to the Education Support program is discussed with parents along with other options that are available within the Department of Education.
