Kindergarten Enrolment Information







Karratha Primary School welcomes students from Kindergarten to Year 6. In Western Australia, children can start their education in Kindergarten, however compulsory schooling starts the following year in Pre-Primary.

Although Kindergarten is not a compulsory year of school, more than 98% of West Australian children attend because it helps give them the best possible start to school.

Placement in a Kindergarten program in a specific school is dependent on the number of places available at that school.

Some schools may receive more applications than they have places. If the number of applications for Kindergarten exceeds the number of places available, then the following selection criteria for enrolment into the Kindergarten program will be applied.

Priority 1 - in area with sibling

Priority 2 - in area without sibling

Priority 3 - out of area with sibling

Priority 4 - area of boundary

Priority 5 - distance from school

Places in Kindergarten may be limited, so we encourage you to apply as early as possible, as late applications may take a lower priority in the allocation of places. Applications for the 2023 school year are now being taken in the Karratha and Dampier areas for Kindergarten. Kindergarten children may be accommodated at the following locations:

KINDERGARTEN APPLICATION TIMELINE FOR 2025 ENROLMENT

Friday 19 July

Applications for Enrolment to a WA School for Kindergarten close.

Friday 30 August

You will be advised in writing, whether or not your application has been accepted.

Friday 20 September

Following the acceptance of your application, you will be required to complete a Student Enrolment Form.

At this time, parents should include an Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) History Statement, no more than 2 months old. It is a Department of Education requirement that all children enrolling in Kindy are fully immunised or on a catch up schedule.
