

The School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges. Financial support provided by parents has always played an enabling role in the provision of resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to students' learning experience. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year. All Contributions and Charges have been kept to a minimum in order to maximise the ability for all families to pay and therefore for all students to benefit from the school's core and non-core programs and activities

## 1 Voluntary Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$50.00 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000 and applies to all students from Kindergarten to Year 6.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the various learning areas. The quality of the teaching and learning programs will be maximised when each family makes its contribution which supplements funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments. Families are welcome to pay off their contributions in instalments, by arrangement.

It is vital for the school to receive your family's contribution and the school offers a number of options to assist parents making their contribution.

- **Option 1** A single contribution of \$50.00 (also can be paid through the '*Student Requirements Lists*').
- **Option 2** Four \$12.50 contributions, all made within the first week of each term.
- **Option 3** Two \$25.00 contributions, both made within the first week of each semester.

## 2 Other Voluntary Approved Requests

The Karratha Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved levy is \$20 per family.

## 3 Charges for Extra Cost Optional Items- Please refer to Page 2

These amounts can vary from year level to year level and from year to year. Students would only incur costs when opting to participate in the activity. Please note that all the activities listed below may not necessarily occur. It is highly desirable however, that students participate in all such activities. The amounts below are indicative only of the **maximum** amount that families may be required to pay in a school year if students are participating in each activity.

## 4 Items for Personal Use: '*Student Requirements Lists*' (Booklists)

The list of items for personal use will vary between Year Level, are owned by your child and your child will need to have the listed materials as they are required each day. The requirements for each student are contained on the year-levelled '*Student Requirements Lists*' and includes stationery, workbooks and consumables. Parents can purchase the '*Student Requirements List*' system or purchase from their supplier of choice. Some items will require replacement during the year.
